Weekly Mow

Weekly mowing of turf grass includes line trimming around tree wells, landscape beds and foundations; edging around all hard surfaces with line trimmer; and clearing drives and sidewalks of grass clippings.

Trim Edges / Sides of Creek
Selectively hand weedeat specific areas.

Early Spring Pre-Emergent

A pre-emergent with a balanced fertilizer to prevent unwanted weeds such as crabgrass and foxtail while feeding the lawn. Does not prevent dandelions or nutsedge.

Spring Weed & Feed

A liquid application of weed and feed to control broadleaf weeds while feeding the lawn. Does not prevent nutsedge.

Grub Preventative

An application of a grub preventative.

Micro-nutrient Fertilizer plus Weed Control

A nutrient-rich fertilizer and spot treated for grassy weeds.

Fall Fertilizer plus Weed Control

A fertilizer application plus pre- and post-emergent herbicide.

Late Fall Winterizer

An application of nutrient-rich fertilizer for the winter.

Aquatic Weed Control Creek Edges/Sides

An aquatic weed control is applied to control

Landscape & Flower Bed Maintenance

Removal of weeds from landscape beds by hand pulling weeds larger than 2". Herbicides are used to control smaller weeds and maintain bed edges.

Hardsurface Non-selective Herbicide A non-selective herbicide is applied to hardsurface areas.

Mulch

Create a clean edge to beds and tree rings unless stated differently above. Install a top dressing of mulch to landscape beds and tree rings.

Edging Beds & Tree Rings Create a natural trenched edge to landscape beds and tree rings.

Prune Shrubs & Trees (up to 12') - Dormant A selective, hard prune done during plant dormancy to rejuivate plant health. Roses Only unless otherwise stated.

Prune Shrubs & Trees (up to 12') - Spring Shaping of landscape shrubs by removal of seasonal growth to maintain size and shape.

Typical shrubs pruned include but are not limited to: Boxwoods, Inkberry, Barberry, Burning Bush, Viburnum, Ninebark, Juniper, Yew

Unless otherwise stated, Excludes: Hydrangeas, Lilacs, Azeleas; upright evergreens such as juniper, arbrovitea and cypress 6' and over.

Prune Shrubs & Trees (up to 12') - Summer Shaping of landscape shrubs by removal of seasonal growth to maintain size and shape.

Typical shrubs pruned include but are not limited to: Boxwoods, Inkberry, Barberry, Burning Bush, Viburnum, Ninebark, Juniper, Yew

Unless otherwise stated, Excludes: Hydrangeas, Lilacs, Azeleas; upright evergreens such as juniper, arbrovitea and cypress 6' and over.

Prune Shrubs & Trees (up to 12') - Fall

Shaping of landscape shrubs by removal of seasonal growth to maintain size and shape.

Typical shrubs pruned include but are not limited to: Boxwoods, Inkberry, Barberry, Burning Bush, Viburnum, Ninebark, Juniper, Yew

Unless otherwise stated, Excludes: Hydrangeas, Lilacs, Azeleas; upright evergreens such as juniper, arbrovitea and cypress 6' and over.

Trim Shrubs to maintain Driver Line of Sight Selective pruning of specialty shrubs such as flowering shrubs, topiary shrubs, and upright evergreens.

Shrub Mid-Spring Insect & Disease Application

Foliar Insecticide application to aid in the control of 1st generation insects on Evergreens, Burning Bush, Azalea and 3rd round of fungicide preventative spray for fungus on Azalea, Euonymus, Lilac, Rose, Quince

Shrub Early Summer Insect Application

Foliar Insecticide application to ornamental shrubs(Evergreens and Burning Bush) to aid in the control of 3rd generation insects.

Tree Mid-Spring Insect & Disease Application

Insecticide application to aid in the control of 1st generation insects and 3rd round of fungicide on Crabapple, Pear, Spruce, Pine, and Juniper

Tree Early Summer Insect Application Insecticide application to aid in the control of 3rd generation insects on Spruce, Pine, and Junipers.

Summer Color

Installation of summer annuals and/or tropical plants. Includes removal of old flowers, soil amendments, and pine bark mulch.

Fall Pansies

Installation of fall pansies. Includes removal of old flowers, soil amendments, and pine bark mulch.

Sprinkler Start-Up

Prepares the irrigation system for start up for the season. This includes turning on the backflow, performing an initial run-through and setting the irrigation controller for optimal coverage. Irrigation technician checks to see that system is in working order, notes any repairs that are needed, and communicates with account manager. Account manager will follow up with needed repairs.

*System operations are weather dependent and may not be recommended to be turned on at the time of start up.

Backflow Test (2 Backflows) Backflow Annual Certification.

Irrigation Run-Through

A thorough diagnostic system check that includes monitoring for leaks, broken or missing heads; adequate coverage; adjust sprinkler heads as necessary; and recommendation of any improvements. If any repairs are needed the technician will communicate to the account manager and the account manager will follow up with the customer.

Irrigation Winterization

Prepares irrigation system for winter to prevent freeze damage. Includes backflow shut off, blowing water out of lines and turning off irrigation controller.

Irrigation Repair Service (\$90 per hour as needed) Repair irriagtion system.
